**Regarding tuition scheme for undergraduate programs**  
**Semester II, Academic Year 2022-2023**

The International University - VNU HCM would like to announce the tuition scheme for undergraduate modules offered in Semester II, Academic Year 2022-2023 as follows:

**1. English modules**

a) Intensive English programs (IE):

- The programs organized by International University: 521.070 VND/credit.

- The programs jointly organized by International University and the University of the West of England: 828.975 VND/credit.

b) Academic English programs (AE): 521.070 VND/credit.

**Note:** Students of International University programs enrolling in the intensive English programs jointly organized by International University and the University of the West of England would pay 828.975 VND/credit.

**2. Specialized and foundation modules**

a) The programs with degrees awarded by International University: 1.373.730 VND/credit.

b) Joint programs with degrees awarded by foreign partner universities:

- Stage 1 (year 1 & 2, with modules offered by International University): 1.942.170 VND/credit;

- Stage 2 (year 3 & 4, with modules offered by foreign partner universities): in accordance with tuition scheme of partner university.

c) 4 + 0 affiliate program, with degrees awarded by the University of the West of England:

- Year 1 & 2: 1.942.170 VND/credit;
- Year 3: 3.552.750 VND/credit;
- Year 4: 3.671.175 VND/credit.

d) 2+2; 2,5; 3+1 affiliate program, with degrees awarded by the University of

Deakin:

- Year 1 & 2: 1.942.170 VND/credit;
- After year 2: 3.197.475 VND/credit.

**3. Other modules:**

a) Modules taught in Vietnamese: 130.268 VND/credit.

b) Physical education: in accordance with notification of Sport Center – VNU

HCM.

c) National defense education: 980.000 VND/student.
